Centralized Move-In

Pick up BuzzCard at CRC

Student will be instructed to check in electronically prior to arriving on campus.

Receive instructions on how to get to their unloading zone (each has their own color).

Travel to Unloading Zone

When you arrive, make sure someone stays with the car at all times.

This is where you will receive help unloading via bins and manpower.

Move to Short-Term Parking

After car is unloaded, move to short-term parking so you can help your student settle in.

Shuttles will be available to residence halls from short-term parking.
