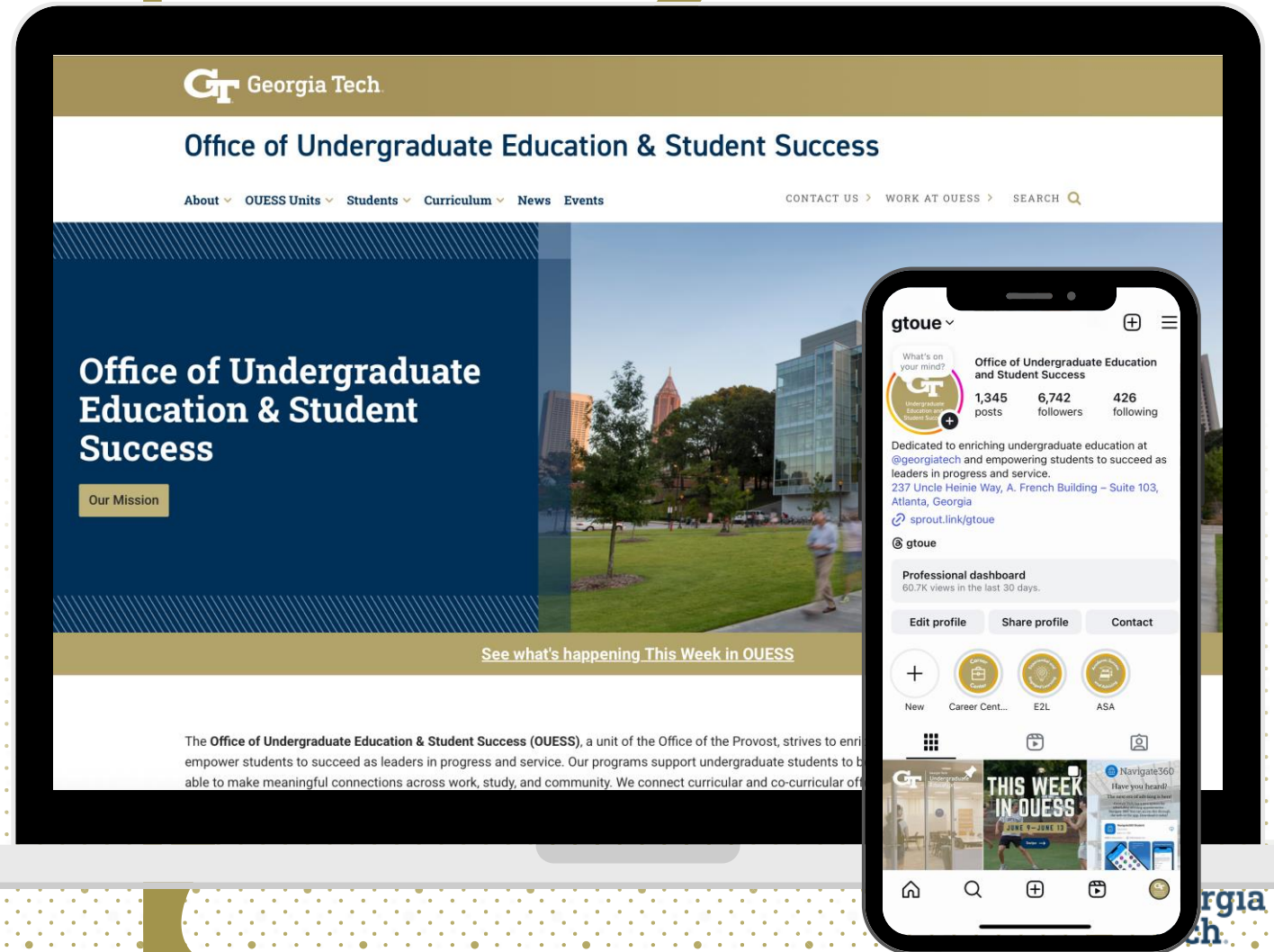

- October 25 Withdrawal Deadline (Fall 2025 courses)
- November 6 Time Ticket Information available online (Phase I)
- November 10-
December 12 Spring 2026 Phase I Registration
- December 31 Time Ticket Information available online (Phase II)
- January 8-16 Spring 2026 Phase II Registration

Important Reminders

- Phase I registration often involves adding to a waitlist
- Encourage students to seek alternative day/time options
- Final schedule should include a balanced combination
- 2nd semester can have higher level of rigor & academic difficulty as major specific courses begin

1-to-1 Tutoring

- By appointment only
- Schedule an in-person or virtual tutoring session with a tutor through Knack
- No additional cost associated with Knack
- Tutor availability varies based on course demand

Group Tutoring (Drop-Ins)

- High-demand 1000 and 2000 level courses
- College Reading and Learning Association (CRLA)-certified peer tutors have earned an A in the course
- Student-led, interactive discussion
- No appointment necessary (schedules posted on website)

Group Tutoring (PLUS)

- Peer Led Undergraduate Study
- Offered twice weekly to keep pace with the lectures
- With regular attendance, PLUS helps students improve their class standing by one-half to one full letter grade
- No appointment necessary (schedules posted on website)

TUTORING AND ACADEMIC SUPPORT

Goal – to develop a self-sufficient learner – a student who can articulate what they don't understand and find resources to help.



1:1 Tutoring

On demand tutoring on the Knack app. GT peer tutors. Supporting over 150+ courses at Tech.



PLUS/LA

Embedded into the classroom tutoring. Tutors work closely with faculty, host office hours, and 2 group style study sessions a week.



Drop-in

No appointment necessary, drop-in tutoring provides a one stop shop for students to meet with tutors or TAs in high demand subject areas.
