Health Fee vs Health Insurance

• Health Fee

- Mandatory for all students
- Cannot be waived
- Covers care only at Stamps Health Services
- Provides 68% of SHS operating revenue
- Covers:
 - Unlimited visits with provider in Primary Care, Women's Health
 - 6 visits with Psychiatry
 - Some labs: strep, mono, UA, preg test, STI tests
 - Flu shots
 - Xrays (including radiologist reading)
- Does not cover: prescriptions, other tests, other vaccinations

• Health Insurance

- Mandatory for some students (F and J visas, GTA's, GRA's), voluntary for others
- Can be waived out of
- Covers charges at Stamps not covered by fee at 100%; can also be used outside of Stamps (specialists, hospital, urgent care)
- Through United Healthcare Student Resources
- USG plan, not a GT plan

Operations

- Open year round (except the week between Christmas and New Years when the Institute is closed)
- Open Monday-Friday, 8a-5p (during summer we close at 4:30p)
- Appointment-based
- Appointments in Primary Care, TIA, and Women's Health can be scheduled online; Psychiatry scheduled through CMHCR.
- Students who walk in without an appointment are triaged by nursing staff.
- FERPA/HIPAA

Finances

- Stamps is financed by student fee dollars and by revenue from clinical activity (pharmacy is the largest source of clinical revenue).
- Stamps does not receive money from the Institute for operations.
- Our largest expenses are people, overhead to the Institute, and pharmacy.
